<b>Medium</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Unprotected close contact (6 ft) with confirmed 2019-nCoV cases, other than high risk category</li> <li>➤ Travelers from mainland China (in the last 14 days)</li> </ul>	Remain at home. Avoid congregate settings, limit public activities and practice social distancing.	Active monitoring <sup>1</sup> or self-monitoring with supervision	Recommend to not travel
<b>Low</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Contact with confirmed 2019-nCoV case other than medium or high risk category</li> </ul>	No restriction	Self-observation <sup>2</sup>	No restriction
<b>No known risk</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Interactions that do not meet the close contact definition (e.g., walking by or sitting more than 6 ft away from)</li> </ul>	No restriction	None	No restriction
