## NYSHFA/NYSCAL Announces 2019 New York National Quality Award Recipients

**ALBANY, NY** – The New York State Health Facilities Association/New York State Center for Assisted Living (NYSHFA/NYSCAL) is pleased to announce that 14 member skilled nursing and assisted living facilities were recognized with the 2019 *Bronze - Commitment to Quality* Award and the 2019 Silver - Achievement in Quality Award by the American Health Care Association and National Center for Assisted Living (AHCA/NCAL). The recipient organizations were honored during AHCA/NCAL's 70th Convention & Expo, October 13-16, 2019 in Orlando, Florida.

Based on the National Institute of Standards and Technology's Baldrige Performance Excellence Program, the AHCA/NCAL National Quality Award Program challenges member providers to achieve excellence in quality through three progressive levels—Bronze, Silver and Gold. Providers begin the quality improvement process at the Bronze level, where they assess their organization's mission, vision, and key factors that lead to success. They also develop an organizational profile and must demonstrate their ability to implement a performance improvement system. Trained examiners review each application to determine if the center has met the demands of the criteria. Members at the Silver award level develop and demonstrate effective approaches that help improve performance and quality outcomes.

"The recipients of the quality awards are making it their mission to deliver quality care for our nation's elders and individuals with disabilities," said Mark Parkinson, President and CEO of AHCA/NCAL. "I'm convinced that because of their commitment, our profession will continue to grow stronger and make a national impact."
