ARTHUR SACER RECEIVES EMPLOYEE RECOGNITION AWARD

ALBANY, N.Y. – Arthur Sacer, Director of Food Services at Salem Hills Rehabilitation & Nursing Center in Purdys, New York has received the 2019 Manager of the Year Award from the New York State Health Facilities Association/New York State Center for Assisted Living (NYSHFA/NYSCAL). Arthur has formed many great relationships with the residents. Each day he greets them as they arrive at the main dining room and even helps with transporting them. Arthur also volunteers in the facility's connector program, where an employee visits with one particular resident on a weekly basis to lift their spirits.
